Accubuilt Completes Strategic Sale of Tuscany Personal Use Operations to DADI, LLC.

Wayne Davis & David Disiere led venture, DADI, LLC, acquires leading manufacturer of specialty vehicles

LIMA, OHIO – Greg Corona, Chairman and Chief Executive Officer of Accubuilt, Inc. announced that Accubuilt has completed the sale of the personal use segment of its Truck & Van Division. Corona further indicated “This divestiture completes the strategic disposition of our specialty truck and van operations so we can focus on building our funeral vehicle, luxury limousine and executive sedan brands”.

Wayne Davis and David Disiere of DADI, LLC announced the acquisition of TUSCANY, the leading manufacturer of specialty vehicles, including luxury vans, personal use mobility vans, hotel shuttle vans, and specialty trucks. The company will continue operations in Elkhart, Indiana with headquarters and product development located in Ft. Worth, Texas.

The move marks the re-entry of Davis into the custom automobile conversion industry where he will be joined by partner Disiere the former CEO of a top insurance MGA based in Dallas, Texas.

“This is a great day for DADI, LLC. We couldn’t be more pleased with this new opportunity because it will rapidly expand our presence in a growing market that is also underserved,” said Wayne Davis, Principal and CEO of TUSCANY.

TUSCANY is ranked #1 with Ford Motor Company in total volume of all personal use specialty vehicle manufactures and has earned Ford’s prestigious Quality Excellence Award a record seven years. The company is also the leader in 12-14 passenger shuttle vans that serve hotel and air transportation markets.

“TUSCANY is the standard in the custom automobile conversion industry. This is a great acquisition for DADI, LLC and fits in perfectly with our overall long term vision,” Disiere added.

Its luxury vans are configured with seven to nine passenger seating with luxury appointments such as 22” LCD’s, DVD, iPod stations, leather seating on both the Ford and GM full size van chassis. Their personal mobility vans are equipped with wheel chair lifts and other adaptive equipment for transporting people in wheelchairs and able-bodied passengers.
